

What is certain:

- An active faith in Christ is a saving faith
- An 'assurance' of salvation that leads us to take the faith lightly is not a godly assurance
- Every Christian is called upon to choose to continue in faith in Christ

- When you're at risk, get closer to other Christians!

Application

Hold tightly to our faith Together

- Christian perseverance is a community endeavor
- Command: Peer-to-peer, not pastor to people
- We must each take (and make) opportunities to strengthen each other's faith in Christ
- At least twice a week, intentionally be in Christian Fellowship → for you and for them

Christian Fellowship


Christian fellowship is more than Christians...
