2 Corinthians 12:1-10

I must go on boasting. Although there is nothing to be gained, I will go on to visions and revelations from the Lord. ² I know a man in Christ who fourteen years ago was caught up to the third heaven. Whether it was in the body or out of the body I do not know—God knows. ³ And I know that this man—whether in the body or apart from the body I do not know, but God knows— ⁴ was caught up to paradise and heard inexpressible things, things that no one is permitted to tell.

Paul outdoes their boasting ... then he nullifies it

⁵ I will boast about a man like that, but I will not boast about myself, except about my weaknesses.
⁶ Even if I should choose to boast, I would not be a fool, because I would be speaking the truth. But I refrain, so no one will think more of me than is warranted by what I do or say, ⁷ or because of these surpassingly great revelations.

Paul wanted to avoid people thinking too highly of him

Therefore, in order to keep me from becoming conceited. I was given a thorn in my flesh, a messenger of Satan, to torment me. 8 Three times I pleaded with the Lord to take it away from me.

God wanted to avoid Paul thinking too highly of himself Satan was unwittingly contributing to God's good work

⁹ But he said to me, "My grace is sufficient for you, for my power is made perfect in weakness." Therefore I will boast all the more gladly about my weaknesses, so that Christ's power may rest on me. ¹⁰ That is why, for Christ's sake, I delight in weaknesses, in insults, in hardships, in persecutions, in difficulties. For when I am weak, then I am strong.

When I am weak in myself and have many troubles...

→ then I can know and show the strength of God
When I am strong in myself and have few troubles...

→ it just looks like I am strong

What are we to do?

In our troubles and weakness, trust in the all sufficient grace of God

- > His power displayed in weakness and trouble
- ➤ In self: humility
- > In others: temptation to trust in them

"In the same way the chief priests and the teachers of the law mocked him among themselves. "He saved others," they said, "but he can't save himself!" Mark 15:31

Because He didn't save Himself (weakness)

He was able to save others

If He had saved Himself

others could not have been saved

In His weakness, the power of salvation came
