Matthew 16:17-19

Peter and the early church

Peter opened the church to...

- > **Jewish** people: Pentecost and 3,000 new people
- > Samaritans: confirming them, Spirit given
- > Gentiles: opening the way to Cornelius

Peter closed the church to...

- Ananias and Sapphira
- > Simon the Sorcerer

...by effectually declaring God's Word


1 Peter 2:4-5


What are we to do?
