
















Prayer is fine.

## The Big Idea

The power to do God's work is in Christ accessed through active faith in Him

#### Three audiences

- Jesus → the 9 apostles
  - ➤ When they didn't have Jesus or the "big 3"
  - > Doing God's work requires faith in God to act
- Matthew → early Church
  - > When Jesus & the eyewitnesses of Jesus were gone
  - > Doing God's work requires faith in God to act
- Jesus → Church throughout the ages
  - > When Jesus & the "greats" of the faith aren't here
  - ➤ Doing God's work requires faith in God to act
