The disciples' journey in Matthew

- 1) Follow Jesus
- 2) Know that Jesus is the Son of God
- 3) Know that Jesus will suffer and die, then be raised to life "From that time on, Jesus began to explain that he must...

suffer... die... on the third day be raised to life."

"Disciples must deny themselves, take up their crosses, and follow me"

Matthew 16:21: Denial Matthew 17:22-23: Grief

Matthew 20:17-19: Seeking greatness in His Kingdom (!) Matthew 26:1-2: Indignant over anointing for burial (!)

The disciples' journey in Matthew

- 1) Follow Jesus

- 3) Know that Jesus will suffer and die, then be raised to life
- 4) Meet Jesus who is risen from the dead
