Matthew 18:1-14

Who is great, and why?
Who is great in God's Kingdom?



1:

The disciples are seeking greatness → in the Kingdom of Heaven

2-4:

God only accepts the lowly → and He honors them

5-6:

skandalizō = to reject or turn away from Jesus to cause someone to reject or turn away from Him Not welcoming the lowly (causing them to stumble) brings the worst imaginable punishment

7-9:

Stumbling or causing stumbling (falling away) is worse than death

10-14:

God pursues & rejoices with the lowly

The Big Idea

God requires lowliness

God pursues & rejoices with the lowly (the only kind of disciple there is) So must we

Value and rejoice with "the lowly"

First century: orphan and widow Who are "the lowly" today?

Value and rejoice with "the lowly": Individually, in households, at work & school, in politics, in small groups, in the church community Because we all are "the lowly"

Find and remove "stumbling blocks"

Anything that hinders us or others from genuinely finding and following Jesus

"But God chose the foolish things of the world to shame the wise; God chose the weak things of the world to shame the strong. God chose the lowly things of this world and the despised things—and the things that are not—to nullify the things that are, so that no one may boast before him. It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God—that is, our righteousness, holiness and redemption. Therefore, as it is written: 'Let the one who boasts boast in the Lord.'"

1 Corinthians 1:27-31
