## **Psalm 104**

<sup>1</sup> Praise the LORD, my soul.      **God controls the heavens**

LORD my God, you are very great;  
you are clothed with splendor and majesty.

<sup>2</sup> The LORD wraps himself in light as with a garment;  
he stretches out the heavens like a tent

<sup>3</sup> and lays the beams of his upper chambers  
on their waters.

He makes the clouds his chariot  
and rides on the wings of the wind.

<sup>4</sup> He makes winds his messengers,  
flames of fire his servants.

- <sup>5</sup> He set the earth on its foundations;  
it can never be moved.      **God controls the earth**
- <sup>6</sup> You covered it with the watery depths      **for creatures**  
as with a garment;  
the waters stood above the mountains.
- <sup>7</sup> But at your rebuke the waters fled,  
at the sound of your thunder they took to flight;
- <sup>8</sup> they flowed over the mountains,  
they went down into the valleys,  
to the place you assigned for them.
- <sup>9</sup> You set a boundary they cannot cross;  
never again will they cover the earth.

- God controls water and food for all creatures**
- <sup>10</sup> He makes springs pour water into the ravines;  
it flows between the mountains.
- <sup>11</sup> They give water to all the beasts of the field;  
the **wild donkeys** quench their thirst.
- <sup>12</sup> The birds of the sky nest by the waters;  
**they sing among the branches.**
- <sup>13</sup> He waters the mountains from his upper chambers;  
the land is satisfied by the fruit of his work.

14 He makes grass grow for the cattle,  
and plants for people to cultivate—  
bringing forth food from the earth:

15 wine that gladdens human hearts,  
oil to make their faces shine,  
and bread that sustains their hearts.

16 The trees of the LORD are well watered,  
the cedars of Lebanon that he planted.

17 There the birds make their nests;  
the **stork** has its home in the junipers.

18 The high mountains belong to the **wild goats**;  
the crags are a refuge for the **hyrax**. **Rock badger**

### **God manages the sun and moon for all creatures**

19 He made the moon to mark the seasons,  
and the sun knows when to go down.

20 **You bring darkness,** it becomes night,  
and all the **beasts of the forest** prowl.

21 The **lions** roar for their prey  
and seek their food from God.

22 The sun rises, and they steal away;  
they return and lie down in their dens.

23 Then people go out to their work,  
to their labor until evening.

- <sup>24</sup> How many are your works, LORD! Even the wildness  
 In wisdom you made them all, of the seas  
 the earth is full of your creatures.
- <sup>25</sup> There is the sea, vast and spacious,  
 teeming with creatures beyond number—  
 living things both large and small.
- <sup>26</sup> There the ships go to and fro,  
 and Leviathan, which you formed to frolic there.

frolic = play energetically

- <sup>27</sup> All creatures look to you God holds all life  
 to give them their food at the proper time.
- <sup>28</sup> When you give it to them,  
 they gather it up;  
 when you open your hand,  
 they are satisfied with good things.
- <sup>29</sup> When you hide your face, All life depends upon God  
 they are terrified;  
 when you take away their breath,  
 they die and return to the dust.
- <sup>30</sup> When you send your Spirit,  
 they are created,  
 and you renew the face of the ground.

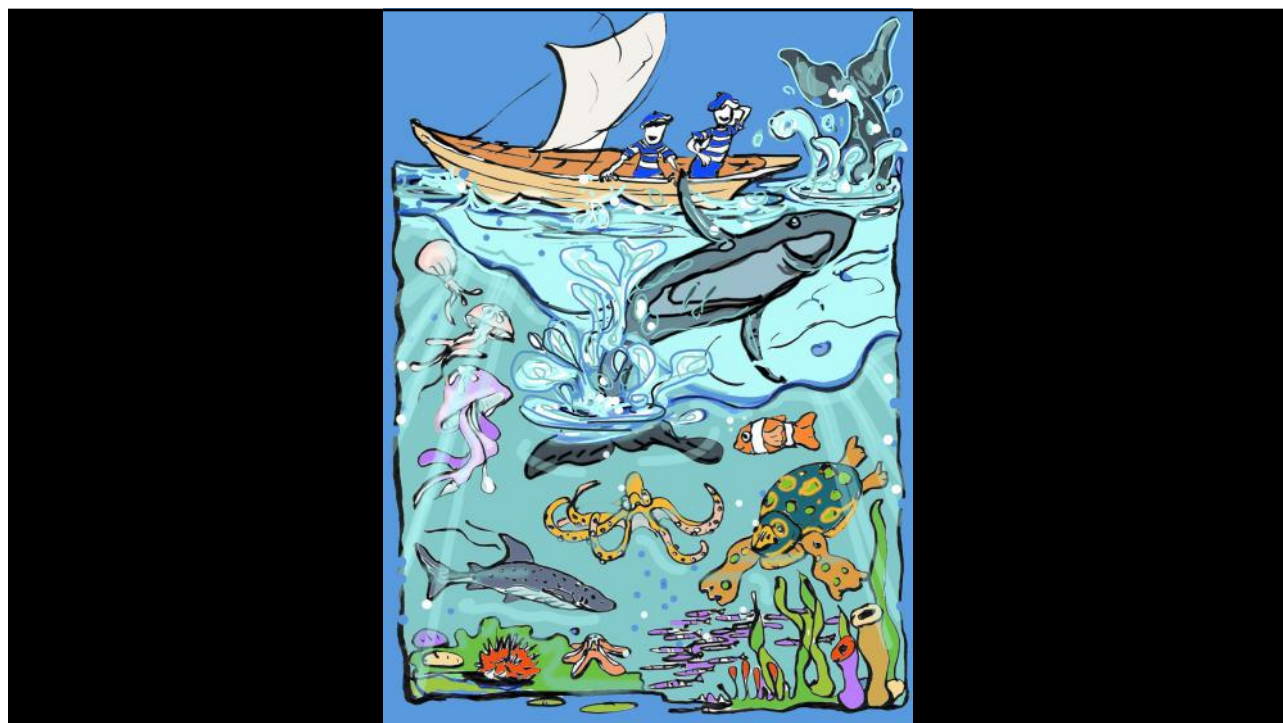
<sup>31</sup> May the glory of the LORD endure forever;

<sup>32</sup> he who looks at the earth, and it trembles,  
 who touches the mountains, and they smoke.

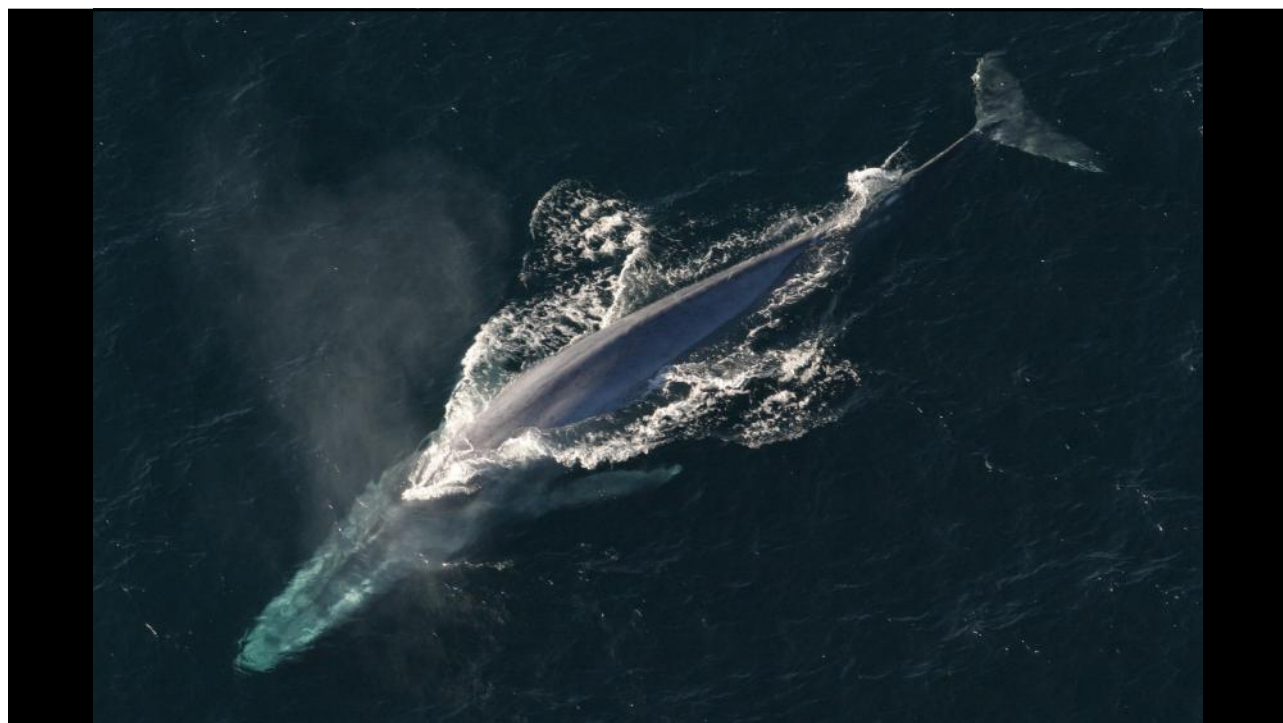
