Though we should be nobodies, lost in oblivion, rejected by God in Jesus we are the forever-loved-family of God

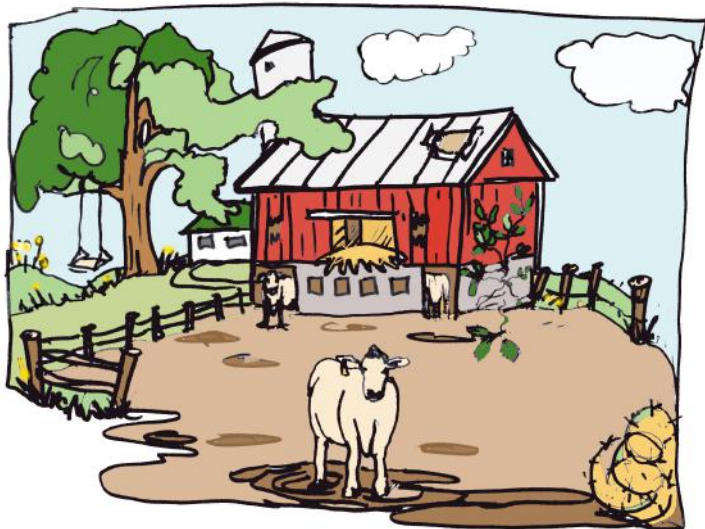
who will live at home with God forever in paradise

## Application

### Come to Jesus

"No one who trusts in him will ever be put to shame."

Everyone who trusts in Him will forever be overjoyed that they did!

**Once:** Accept by faith the forgiveness and mercy that Jesus died to give

**Always:** Keep turning more fully to Him

### Rejoice in God's grace to save and love

In Jesus, God gives the love we don't deserve

Darkness → Marvelous light

Not a people → God's own people

Not received mercy → Received mercy

**Rejoice in the Lord always!**

### Make known God's grace

"the fruit of lips that openly profess his name"

Words, actions, creations, productivity

The sum of our expression = our core convictions about the world (Schaeffer)

Our vision: "The peoples of all nations being transformed by Christ together to the glory of God"
