

“Don’t sweat the small stuff”

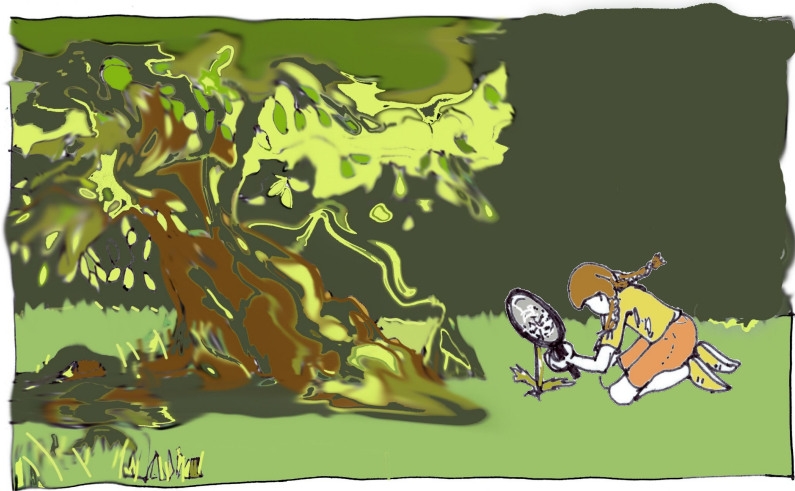
- Don’t let concern about little things spoil life

Jesus' return should change how we live

"Since everything will be destroyed in this way, what kind of people ought you to be? **You ought to live holy and godly lives as you look forward to the day of God and speed its coming.**"

Jesus taught this repeatedly

"For **the Son of Man is going to come in his Father's glory with his angels**, and then he will reward each person according to what they have done"

Matthew 16:27

"Therefore, when **the owner of the vineyard comes**, what will he do to those tenants?"

Our "Statement of Faith"

Putting it into practice

Be shaped by Scripture

- "You will do well to pay attention to it"
- Nothing else reveals God's plans and how we can prepare for them
- One of our Core Values: the Bible
 - **God** spoke and still speaks in the Bible
 - So **the Bible is central** in our lives (individually and together)

Putting it into practice

Take seriously the return of Jesus to judge all

- Our entire lives have been in a dark age
- **But the Day is coming and the Son of God will rise and reign!**

Is the return of Jesus to reign real?

- **Peter: Yes! Confirmed by...**
 - the Bible
 - the audible voice of God
 - the visible glory of Jesus
as seen by eyewitnesses who then died for it

Is it relevant for us today?

- Jesus: “**Therefore keep watch**, because you do not know on what day your Lord will come.”
Matthew 24:42
- Jesus: “**Be on guard! Be alert!** You do not know when that time will come.”
Mark 13:33
- Paul: “So then, let us not be like others, who are asleep, but **let us be awake and sober.**”
1 Thessalonians 5:6

Is it serious?

- Jesus said: "Do not be afraid of those who kill the body but cannot kill the soul. Rather, **be afraid of the One who can destroy both soul and body in hell.**"
